has revolutionised the manner in which the AIADMK government took up the initiative to conserve water resources in the State.

Involving farmers, the government undertaken kudimaramathu work in 6,278 water bodies spent Rs. 1,433 cr.

Palaniswami said, I have people's faith, My priority is the welfare of the people of Tamil Nadu. I will continue to work for Tamil Nadu

Speaking about covid measures Palaniswami said, "Tamil Nadu is continuing its strategy of aggressive, targeted testing and is currently conducting the maximum number of PCR tests in the country. Tamil Nadu presently has 130 labs for COVID testing with 61 Government and 69 private labs, with an average testing capacity of 65,000 tests per day. These tests cost nearly 5 crore rupees a day. I request Government of India to

fund 50% of the cost of the PCR tests from the PM - CARES fund.

As on date, 32,92,958 samples have been tested for COVID-19, out of which 3,02,815 persons were tested positive and 53,099 active cases are in the State currently. Tamil Nadu provides effective medical treatment due to which the State has maintained a low death rate, which is now at 1.6%, one of the lowest in the country. As on date, 2, 44,675 patients have recovered, which works out to a recovery rate of 80.8%, one of the highest in the country. Among 37 districts, containment measures are being carried out in 36 districts.

All front-line workers are being given Kabasura Kudineer, Zinc and Multi vitamin tablets, in addition to prophylactic Hydroxy - chloroquine as per medical advice. The capacity of COVID hospitals, COVID Health Centres and COVID Care Centres has been increased to

1,29,024 beds, which includes 33,576 beds in COVID hospitals, 22,873 in COVID health centres and 72,575 beds in COVID Care Centres. 4,147 ventilators have been made available including 630 in the private sector.

In order to handle the emergency situation, 2,751 Doctors, 6,893 Staff Nurses, 1058 Lab Technicians, 334 Health Inspectors, 2,751 Multipurpose Health Workers and 2,000 Paramedical Workers have been drafted.

Earlier in a bid to avoid untoward incidents, city police had made arrangements for Independence day celebrations and traffic was diverted too. As many as 15,000 police personnel were deployed. A control room to monitor the CCTVs was also set up and police have identified ten sensitive places in the city.
